## White Wines

- Parducci Sustainable **White** 2010, Mendocino, CA \$18  
*Peach, apricot, and ripe melon flavors, fruit forward, with floral accents*
- Acrobat **Pinot Gris** 2012, OR \$23  
*Aromas of pear, citrus, and honeydew melon with flavors of mandarin orange, lemon, kiwi, pear, and spice*
- Simi **Chardonnay** 2012, Sonoma County, CA \$30  
*Jasmine and rose petal with flavors of tropical fruit, roasted hazelnut, and almond butter.*
- MacMurray Ranch **Pinot Gris** 2013, Russian River Valley, California \$27  
*Spiced pear, apple, lemon flavors are set on a supple bod, with a good jolt of acidity keeping the flavors fresh*
- Kenefick Ranch **Pickett Road White** 2013, Calistoga, CA \$38  
*Light and dry, with aromas of orange and lime, with a crisp finish*
- Bodega Norton Cosecha Tardia Late Harvest 2010, Argentina \$40  
*Forward and medium-sweet, with modest pineapple and papaya notes lingering through the soft finish*
- Trimbach **Riesling** 2011, Alsace, France \$39  
*Well-meshed flavors of apple, beeswax and lemon preserves, with a streak of salinity echoing on the finish*
- Grgich Hills Estate **Chardonnay** 2011, Napa Valley, CA \$70  
*Core of lime, grapefruit and flinty green apple notes. Cleansing on the finish.*
- Freixenet Cordon Negro **Sparkling**, NV, Spain \$23  
*Delicate aromas of ripe apple and peach*

## Red Wines

- Kenefick Ranch **Pickett Road Red** 2010, Calistoga, CA \$70  
*Elements of plum, fresh berries, and vanilla spice, well-rounded tannins on the finish.*
- Domaine de Pallus, Pensees de Pallus 2011, **Cabernet Franc**, Chinon, France \$36  
*Blackberry, black currant, and roasted tobacco leafnotes, broad and smoky finish, with hints of violet*
- Bodegas Ordonez Zerran 2011, Montsant, Spain **Garnacha, Mazeulo and Syrah** \$31  
*Bright red fruit, spice and vanilla flavors in a supple texture, with tender tannins and fresh acidity*
- Justin **Cabernet Sauvignon** 2012, Paso Robles California \$46  
*Vivid blackberry and wild berries, with a lingering finish*
- Silver Oak **Cabernet Sauvignon** 2009, Alexander Valley California \$100  
*Black plum, blackberry, and baking spices, flavors of berry cobbler, with a long fruity finish*
- Delaforce **Touriga Nacional** 2012, Douro, Portugal \$30  
*Effusively fruity, with raspberry and dark cherry. Strawberry and cream notes on the finish.*
- Quivira Dry Creek Valley, California **Zinfandel** 2011 \$36  
*Crisp and nicely focused, with bright cherry and underbrush aromas and zesty raspberry and herb flavors*
- Earthquake **Petite Syrah** 2010, Lodi, California \$45  
*Smoke, cedar, and bacon fat notes give way to a wild berry and pomegranate flavors, with rustic tannins*
