Restaurant Usage and COVID-19 Restrictions

We are excited to get the go ahead to open our patio up to dining for the members. We will have this available starting Wednesday May 6th. With these new restriction easements we have also received different guidelines from the state health department to maintain a safe environment for our members, guests and staff.

Our hours of operation are being extended. Bar service will be available 11am-8pm, to-go food and patio dining will be available 11am-2pm, then 4pm-8pm, Tuesday - Saturday. The kitchen will close each afternoon for a deep sanitation, but bar service will remain. Sunday we will offer bar service only from 12:30-6.

Tables for patio dining will fill quickly, to ensure you have seating please call ahead for reservations or to see if seating is available. Tables and chairs are set specifically to state guidelines, please DO NOT move any tables together or to other areas of the patio. Seating is limited to six people per table at this time. We have our menus up and ready to-go with slight variations. The lunch menu is available 11am-2pm and the Dinner menu available 4pm-8pm. We will have a few select additional items available during dinner hours. The restaurant and bar will remain closed inside, please do not enter those areas. We ask for your understanding with certain food items as many of our normal products have been seemingly more difficult to obtain or have received not up to our standards.

Comment cards are still available to fill out for management to hear your suggestions regarding food and operations. Dining on the patio will be weather permitting. If weather proves to be uncooperative we will close outside dining, however to-go food and drinks will be consistently available during these times. Five people are permitted within the building at any time to pick up to-go food or use the restroom/locker room. We happily accommodate any members that need within the building for those purposes. Feel free to call the dining room for prompt service or ring the bell located on the rock wall of the side door for staff attention.

We are thankful for your continued support throughout this time both with to-go food and drink and patience with staff who are quickly having to learn new policies and procedures to keep themselves and our members safe and healthy. These policies clubhouse staff are directed to uphold are direct state recommendations, any concerns or comments can be directly taken up with Dale Telford, GM. You many have seen the beverage cart out during your game! We have opened up one cart each day, so keep your eyes peeled for the cart girls! Cart hours this month will also depend on weather and activity. We are still only accepting member charges and credit cards for payment. No cash will be accepted.

We appreciate your cooperation, patience and understanding as we learn and quickly adapt to health updates and guidelines. The health and safety of our members and staff is the Clubs top priority and we value each of your efforts in keeping our environment as healthy as it can be for a prompt reopening. We look forward to seeing you all very soon.

(When entering your account number add a "1" at the end of your number IE: account 123 enter 1231)
- Joining the ladies golf association includes entry to our 3 evening tournaments, Kick off and Last Blast as well as weekly play of the day.

Our 3 evening tournaments are all 2 person teams. Following play there is a buffet dinner and cocktails on your own plus awards. These tournaments are a great way to get to know other members of the club.

Play of the day is a different fun event each week. You can sign up weekly via email from the pro shop then you will be paired by the pro shop. Gather on the putting green or short range for the tip of the day and announcements at 8:15 then head to your hole for an 8:30 start. Can't play early - make your own group but still participate in the play of the day. Just record your scores in the ladies locker room after golf.
