Greetings Everyone!

Before we know it, the great summer weather will be here, and we will enjoy the speedy greens and lush fairways!

The CCC Board of Directors and staff have been working hard at providing you with a few new events and golf details for the 2023 season. A few are listed below but you will see more information during April.

- 1) New handicap allocations. (The order in which scorecards will be "dotted.")
- 2) New format for the Men's Season-long Match-Play.
- 3) Advanced Junior Golf Program. (This program is available to youth golfers that have participated in the Junior Golf Program and show passion for continuing their golf career in a more competitive atmosphere. We are working out the final details, but the program will run in June, July, and August.)
- 4) Additional Parent/Child Tournament. (We have added another Parent/ Child Tournament to have a tournament during the summer. Please save the dates for June 18th, July 9th, and August 20th)

This year's first event is the Men's Kick-off on Sunday, April 30th, with breakfast at 7:30 AM and a shotgun start at 9:00 AM (the golf shop will make the pairings). If the weather doesn't cooperate, the event will be rescheduled for Sunday, May 7th.

The Little Dilly Member-Guest has filled up in record time, this is a testament to the fantastic 2022 event and the Little Dilly board deserves a shout-out for their hard work.

The Junior Golf Program will continue using the American Development Method, "ADM." This year's program will offer a four- day golf camp with athletes ages ten and older from 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM and nine and under from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM. We will run two camps throughout the summer. The 1st camp will be held on June 12th-15th, and the 2nd camp is July 10th-13th. Your athlete can participate in either camp or both. The Junior Club Championship is on August 7th. Thank you in advance for your participation! Junior Golf information packets and sign-ups will be available on May 1st.

Thank you, Wildcatters! They have graciously donated \$2,000 to the junior program to help us stay up-to-date on our training aids and games.

Many of you have been working on your game, whether participating in the winter lesson program, playing in the simulators, or traveling to warmer weather. I want to remind everyone that April is a great time to evaluate your clubs and grips. Please call the golf shop or stop in to discuss how we can help prepare your bag for the season.
