

I would like to thank all the members for their Employee Christmas Bonus contributions. All the employees truly appreciate your generosity and your appreciation for their efforts throughout the year.

We will inform you of Dining Room closures due to scheduled Christmas Parties. Please pay attention to your weekly emails, text messages from the club and the December calendar.

Speaking of the Dining Room, many of you have come out and tried Chef Matt's Cuisine and for those of you who have not had the opportunity you're missing out. Back in August the House Committee and I talked about making an organizational change and bringing in a new chef. We also talked about COGS (Cost of Goods Sold), this is a key indicator as to the effectiveness of the current menu and how we utilize the ingredients that are brought in to execute the menu. After much discussion it was decided to pair-down the menu and offer fewer items but be more consistent and have better quality with the menu choices. By pairing down the menu it will be easier to control COGS and cut down on the waste that we have been experiencing.


