Dear Members of the Casper Country Club,

We hope this message finds you in good spirits and health. Today, we must address a subject that is vital for the continued excellence and operation of our Club - the adjustment of our membership dues.

For the fourth consecutive year, we find ourselves in a position where increasing the dues has become necessary. We understand that this decision may bring varied reactions, and we want to assure you that it was not made lightly. The Board has undertaken extensive deliberations and examined various alternatives before arriving at this conclusion.

The driving force behind this decision is the relentless rise in the cost of goods, a trend that unfortunately shows little sign of retreating. These increases impact all aspects of our Club, particularly our cherished member dining experience in the restaurant, which faces its own challenges due to inconsistent usage and the inherent seasonality of our operations.

In considering the dues increase, the Board was mindful of the impact on our valued members. The State of Wyoming's Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) calculation permits an increase of over 4% this year. However, in an effort to balance the need for financial stability with the interests of our members, the Board has chosen to implement a lesser increase.

Simultaneously, the Board has tasked management across all departments with a critical mission - to enhance revenue generation and improve margins. This directive is not merely about increasing dues; it's a comprehensive strategy aimed at ensuring the sustainability and enhancement of the Club's offerings while maintaining our commitment to excellence.

We believe these steps are crucial for the future of the Casper Country Club. They will enable us to continue providing the high standard of services and facilities you have come to expect and cherish.

We appreciate your understanding and continued support in these challenging times. Our commitment to providing an exceptional Club experience remains unwavering, and we are confident that together, we will navigate these changes with the grace and resilience that define our community.
