FROM THE PRO SHOP

Spring is right around the corner, and we have been working hard teaching the winter program, cleaning, and finalizing the golf calendar. As you already know, the golf calendar is very busy, and we are confident that we will have some great experiences for all our members and guests. The Board and Golf Committee are very conscious of the golf schedule and sensitive to outside play. We hope this year's schedule will generate the needed revenue for the entire club while providing various playing opportunities for the membership. Dates and events can be found on the Casper Country Club website and sign-up links will be provided soon.

This winter has been nothing but uneventful! Along with the winter program, the golf shop and the golf committee have been working hard at providing a few exciting new things for the 2024 golf season! You may have already seen the information below, but I feel that it is worthy of at least one more post. Please see below and call if you have any questions or concerns. The golf shop is here for you!

- 1. Golf Shop Hours: (Depending on Winter Program Lessons)
 - a. Sunday and Monday: Closed
 - b. Tuesday, Thursday, & Friday: 9:00am to 7:00pm
 - c. Wednesday: 12:00pm to 8:00pm
 - d. Saturday: 10:00am to 6:00pm

2. Upcoming Events:

- a. Save the date for the Little Dilly Member-Guest on June 26th-29th
 (Registration will open on Friday, March 15th @ 9:00AM MST- Set a reminder!)
- b. Callaway Demo Day: March 9th@ 12:00pm-4:00pm (Indoor and must sign-up with the golf shop.)
- c. Titleist Demo Day: March 14th @ 3:00pm-7:00pm (Indoor and must sign-up with the golf shop.)
- d. PXG Demo Day: March 23rd @ 12:00pm-5:00pm (Indoor and must sign-up with the golf shop.)

3. New Technological Advancements:

- a. Cap Patrol: A product used by 1,100 clubs and courses nationwide and more than 620,000 golfers that will monitor our tee sheet and the USGA GHIN handicap system. Cap Patrol will give us up-to-date reports that will give recommendations on accurate tournament handicaps. This new system will help with the longevity of our events and create a more equitable playing field. The USGA is looking at purchasing Cap Patrol or developing a program like Cap Patrol, so Casper Country Club will be one of the first clubs in Wyoming to utilize the product before it goes live with the USGA. All players that have a GHIN handicap will be required to be involved in this new system. The cost will be added to the increase of the GHIN dues. More details at www.cappatrol.com or Google Golf Digest's "How to catch a sandbagger".
- b. USGA GHIN Handicap: The Wyoming Golf Association has effectively merged with the Colorado Golf Association. The direct result has increased our GHIN dues \$10 beginning in 2024. We currently charge \$50 for a GHIN. The GHIN fee for 2024 will become \$70 per player and we would like all golfers to have a GHIN handicap. (All CCC events require an active GHIN.)
- c. Shopmyshop.com: An online store where members can purchase products with Casper Country Club's logo. The site will provide members with an increased variety of golf clothing like Peter Millar, Greyson, Johnnie-O, Ralph Lauren, Lululemon and many others. This option could be a great place to order your team uniforms for Member-Guest, Member-Member, Parent-Child, Par, then bar, etc... (We are not up and running yet but more details to come!)
- d. Online Tee Sheet: Access and book tee times through the same login portal used for viewing CCC bills. Please test it out!

We hope you continue to have a great winter and, again, come and see us at the shop so that we may assist you with any of your "golfing" needs.
