Greetings Everyone!

Spring has arrived! The greens are uncovered, pallets are out of the bunkers, and we are now just waiting for the grass to grow a little faster. Before we know it, the course will be in excellent playing condition.

This year's first event is the Men's Kick-off on Saturday, May 4th. Breakfast will be at 8:30 AM, and a shotgun start will be at 10:00 AM. The golf shop will make the pairings.

The Little Dilly Member-Guest has filled up again in another record time. This is a testament to the fantastic 2023 event, and the Little Dilly committee deserves a shout-out for their hard work. Although the Little Dilly is currently full, we strongly suggest that you register for the waiting list, as there is still a chance you could get into one of the season's best events.

The Junior Golf Program will continue using the American Development Method, "ADM." This year's program will offer a four-day golf camp with athletes ages ten and older from 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM and nine and under from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM. We will run two camps throughout the summer. The 1st camp will be held on June 17th-20th, and the 2nd camp is July 22nd-25th. Your athlete can participate in either camp or both. The Junior Club Championship is on August 5th. Thank you in advance for your participation! Junior Golf information packets and sign-ups will be available on May 1st.

We will continue the Advanced Junior Program along with the Junior Program. If you have a Middle school-aged junior player who would like to further their skills, please call the golf shop for more information.
